



PINKROOM CUP 2015 NAIL COMPETITION



GENERAL RULES

1. The following rules are common to all competition categories. It is essential that all competitors adhere to them.
2. Please ensure that you have read & understood the rules. Kindly contact the academy at +65 63481592 or email prcup@the-pinkroom.com should you have any questions.
3. Strict timings must be adhered to. Please refer to the individual category rules & time schedule.
4. The judging panel of members comprise of renowned and honourable members, who are actual judges representing different nail companies, as well as judges of the qualification cycle.
5. This competition is open to all manicurists working with professional products and who are duly registered.
6. Competitor numbers will be given upon registration on the competition day. One is for your competition t-shirt and the other is for your models competition hand. You are to sit according to your competition number.
7. Should a competitor be found to be registered in the wrong division, she would be reassigned to the relevant division. Competitors will be informed accordingly.
8. It is compulsory for all competitors to wear the school's apron, competition T-shirt, a face-mask and neat bun-up hair before the start of the competition.
9. Please dress presentably as there will be professional photographers, reporters, important international VIP guests etc. Slippers and casual clothing is not recommended.
10. A Nail Check Form will be given to all competitors before the start of the competition. Competitors are to make a remark on the form to inform of any cuts on the model's hand prior to the competition.
11. After filling up the form, raise your hand for the Competition supervisory committee to verify.
12. After Nail Check, competitors are not allowed to work on model's hands (shorten, smooth, clean the nails, disinfect, and apply bonds or primers etc). All this work is done after the start of the competition.
13. Models must not wear any identifiable garments with logos or advertising of any kind. Jewellery must be removed. Competition T-shirt will be given to the models to wear. Models should also wear comfortable shoes as they may also be required to stand for some time during judging. Please do inform your model that judging can sometimes take up to 2 hours.
14. In the event where competition work is to be done only on one hand, the other hand should have nails covered with red polish before the competition start.
15. Competitors must provide their own model, lighting, extension cords, towels, water, waste bag, plastic table-liner & all materials needed for competition.
16. The Organizing Committee will provide a table, a power supply and two chairs for each competitor/team. In case the competitor needs more than one electric appliance or extra lighting, please bring your own extension wire and table lamp. Extension cords and adapters will not be provided.
17. Hot water will not be provided during the competition. Competitors may prepare their own water into a container & place on the table as part of setup.
18. Once seated for briefing, all personal belongings must be stored neatly under the table. Please note that once briefing starts competitors are NOT allowed to retrieve any items from their belongings. Points may be deducted if this happens.
19. If you need to retrieve a product from their bag or kit, kindly raise hand and ask the floor judge for permission.
20. All products/pump dispensers/bottles etc must be correctly labelled. Manufacturers' labels are acceptable and must be in English.
21. All mobile phones MUST be switched off (including models' phones). Competitors will be disqualified should your phones ring/ is answered during the competition. Towards the end of the competition, kindly switch your phone to "silent" mode, for your model to contact you once they have been judged.
22. Timers and watches are allowed to keep track of the timing. Mobile phones cannot be used as a timer.
23. Please ensure that you adhere to the rules of your individual category. Products not allowed in the respective category will be removed from your desk, and you may be disqualified.
24. The floor judges will be scrutinizing working practices. Marks will be awarded for hygiene, tidiness and presentation. Your desk should be neat and well-organised with a waste bag and a sanitation system.
25. Smoking or eating is NOT allowed during the competition or in the competition area. It is important that you and your model eat prior to the start, and visits the ladies just prior to briefing!
26. Towards the end of the competition, competitors MUST leave the competition area until judging is complete. Please remove all your belongings (including your model's) The organizers will not be held responsible for these items at any time. You will be informed when you are allowed to pack your kit away.
27. Models are to remain in the competition area until judging is complete, as they are most likely subjected to be re-judged. It will be the model's responsibility to ensure that they are vetted by all judges. Should they be in doubt, kindly ask a member of the Competition Supervisory Committee BEFORE leaving the judging area.
28. Models who have left the competition area or judging area will NOT be allowed back in.
29. In the event the judging results in a tie, and there is a dispute, the judge panel's decision will be final. Rules and regulations or amendments will remain at the discretion of the competition.
30. The competitor will be disqualified in ANY of the following cases:
 - Late arrival at the competition;
 - Irregular behaviour on the competition floor;
 - If she doesn't respect the order to stop the work after the end of the scheduled time;
 - Leaving the competition area without permission;
 - Using forbidden products or equipment (mentioned in the regulations);
 - For any jewellery on model's hand.
31. The decision on disqualification can be made only by the Judge panel. Floor judges & Competition supervisory committee members are not entitled to do this. They only make notes on the violations and bring it to the attention of the Judge panel.
32. All competitors are expected to be fully insured and work is carried out at their own risk.
33. Photographs may be taken by official photographers and magazine reporters at any point in the competition and The Pink Room International Nail Academy reserves the rights to use the all works & photos submitted and photos taken at the event.
34. All registrations process must be completed at The Pink Room International Nail Academy (International Plaza #06-18) or via online registration (www.the-pinkroom.com/prcup/prcup-reg-form.php). No entries will be taken by telephone & mail.
35. Acknowledgement will be given once the competition fee is received. Registration is void if competition fees have not been made upon registration.
36. Entry forms submitted after the deadline date, if accepted, will be charged an additional fee. Places will NOT be guaranteed for entries submitted AFTER the deadline date or for those who enter on the day. Your competition entry confirmation letter will be sent upon receipt of cleared payment.
37. Entry constitutes an agreement with the rules and regulations.
